

We then explored the list of values with our class in circle times. Classes also had an opportunity to add more values to it. We discussed what some of the values meant and started to choose some values that we thought would be a good fit for Moss Hey.

After a few circle times each class chose 5 values that they thought were good for the whole Moss Hey community



Selecting our Values

In our next school council meeting we discussed the words that had been selected by each class and made a mind map of the values - putting the values into categories.

From this we were able to narrow the values down to a choice of 8 and these covered the different types of values.

Classes then discussed further their preference and really thought about their reasons and why their choices would be good for the whole school community. Staff were also consulted and shared their choices and reasons
