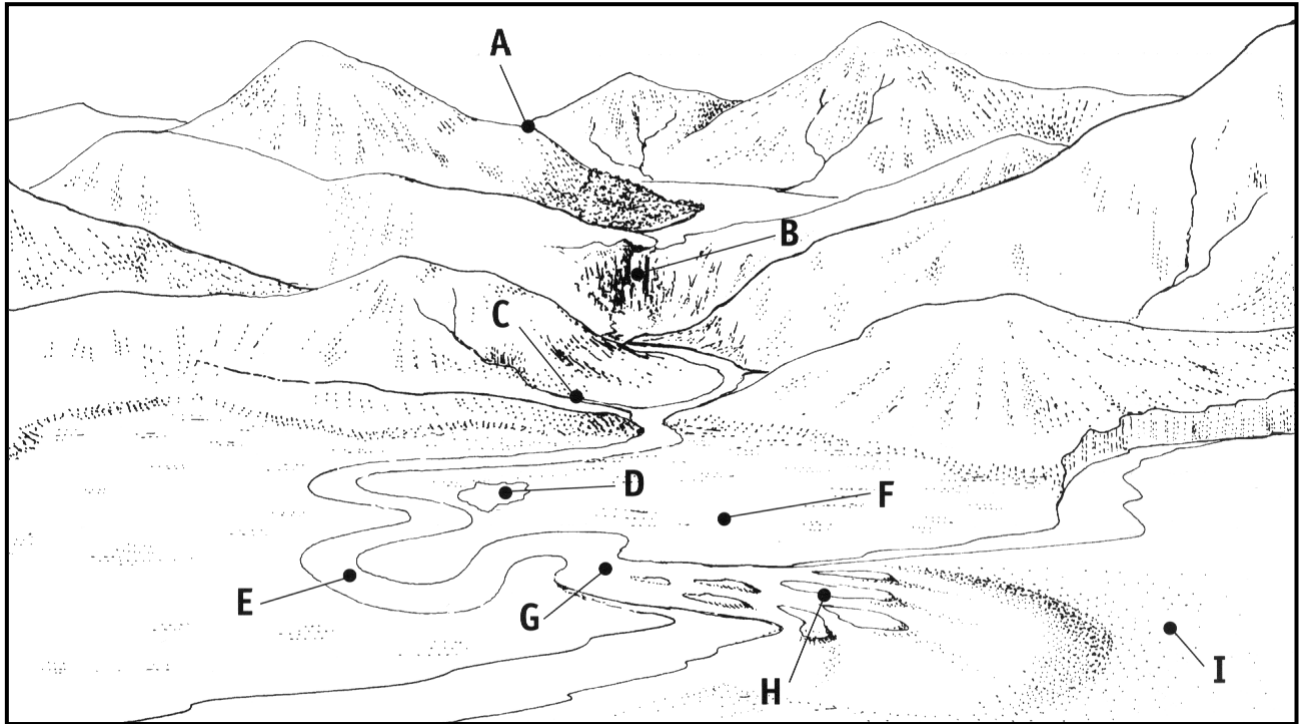


Labelling Parts of a River
