




- 1. The female butterfly lays her egg on a leaf.

Butterflies live in lots of different places depending on what season it is. They are cold-blooded insects so like to live in warm places and can be found in many countries around the world. Butterflies tend

to live where they can find food; if there is no food supply in an area, they will move on to somewhere else. They are active during the day looking for food and at night may be found on the underside of a leaf or tucked away in a crevice in a rock

What Do They Eat?

Butterflies get all of the food they need by drinking. They have a long, thin tube in their mouth called a 'proboscis', which they use like a straw to suck up their food. Adult butterflies eat all sorts of things, including juices from fruit like oranges and watermelons, nectar from different types of flowers, and water. They have sensors on the bottom of their feet so that when they land on something they can taste it.



Staying Safe

Many species of butterflies have eye spots on their wings. If a predator comes near, they flutter their wings, showing their eye spots, which often scares the predator away. If a predator attacks, the butterfly can usually still fly away with a small amount of damage to their wings. Some butterflies are poisonous or taste horrible and bright colours usually warn other animals of this.






