They each took a balloon and waved it towards the sky.



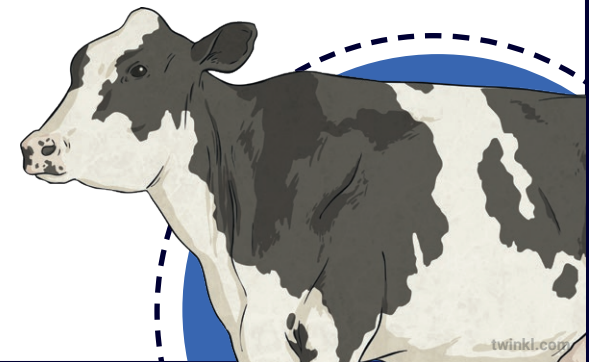
What's the Problem?

He took the centre of the doughnut and placed it in a box.



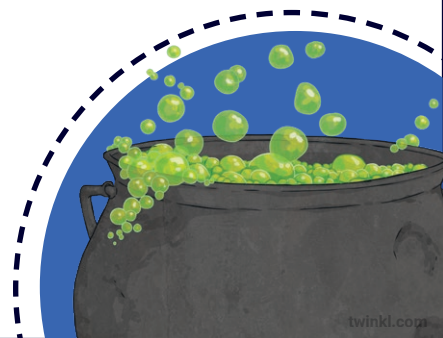
What's the Problem?

The cow was shut in the barn and the door was padlocked shut.



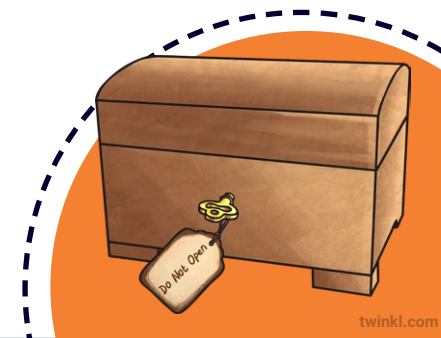
What's the Problem?

She sealed the box, which was shaking violently, and walked away.



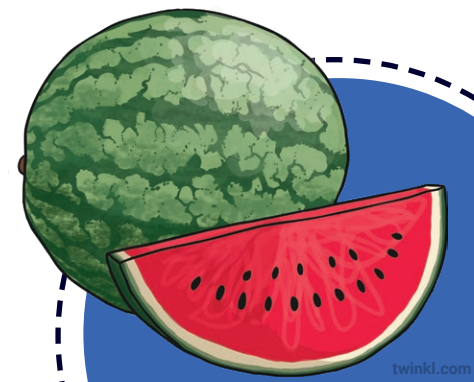
What's the Problem?

She tied her socks to her glasses and began to run.



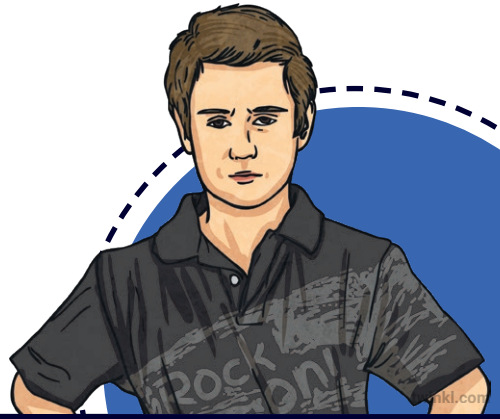
What's the Problem?

The children sold the remaining watermelons for 50p each.



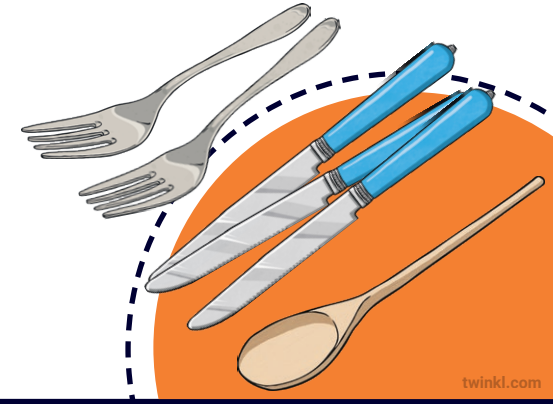
What's the Problem?

Two forks, three knives and a wooden spoon was all they needed.



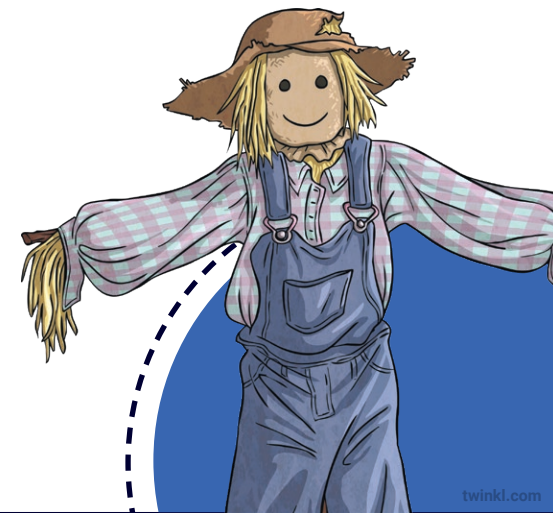
What's the Problem?

The girl put the small coin in her pocket and vowed to never tell anybody what had just happened.



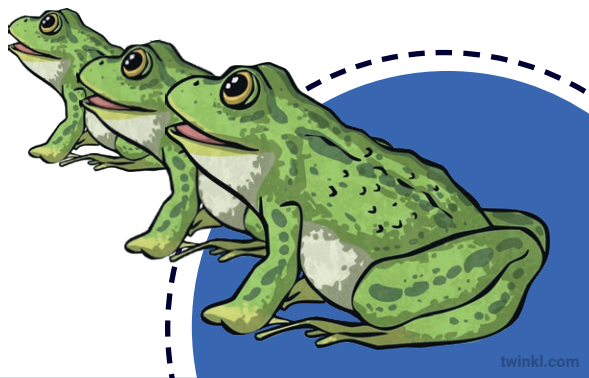
What's the Problem?

All of the frogs linked their arms together and began to push.



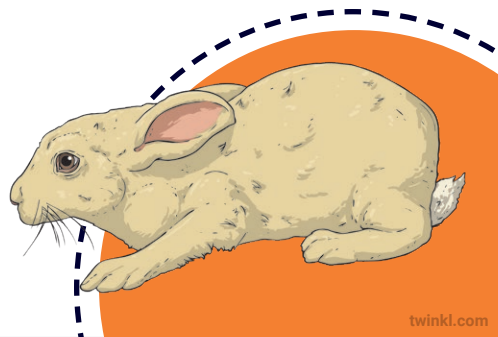
What's the Problem?
