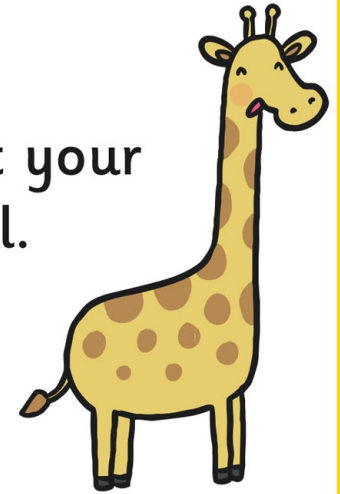

Write a poem about the seasons.

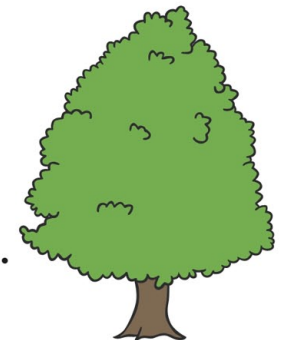


Poem Challenge
